Our Expectations

A successful volunteer will possess the following qualities:

- Outgoing and friendly;
- Enjoy working with young people;
- Will maintain the highest professional standards on a par with the teaching staff;
- Have experience in some of the following areas: Sports -Swimming, Football, Tennis, Golf, Basketball; Arts - Musicals, Visual Arts, Instrumental lessons, Dance, Drama; Academic Subjects; Learning Support; Design Technology; Primary & Early Years; Computing; Robotics;
- May have some experience working with young people in a residential capacity.

Aims/Duties

- Providing support related to experience and subject specification
- Develop a professional understanding of teaching or coaching as a vocation
- Collaborating with teachers or coaches on a daily basis to provide high quality teaching and learning for students at BISP
- Assisting with after school activities
- Getting involved in the wider community and cultural life of the school
- Assisting with residential and educational visits outside of Phuket
- Assisting Boarding House Parents with the weekend and evening activity program
- Initiating team building, team games and sporting competitions for boarders

BISP is located on the beautiful island of Phuket, approximately 860 km south of the capital, Bangkok. It is a comprehensive day and boarding school, providing quality education for pupils aged from 2 years to 18 years. Interns have contributed to the success of BISP from our earliest days and their role continues to be an integral part of daily academic, extra-curricular and boarding life.



Benefits

- Interns are housed in individual rooms in one of our Boarding houses free of charge;
- Rooms are fitted with beds, bedding, wardrobes, mirror and air-conditioning;
- Communal area;
- Three meals a day during school term time;
- Free laundry during school time;
- Interns paid approximately 11100 baht per month;
- Interns are offered free group transportation with a school driver and minibus to a destination on the island, once a week, subject to availability;
- Health and accident insurance while in Thailand (Holiday trips will require personal insurance);
- References provided upon completion of service;
- Holidays include one week in October; three weeks around Christmas time; one week in February and two weeks in April. Volunteers can travel during these times in the Asia region;
- Interns are paid from August to June

- Sport coaching experience;
- Professional development with teaching staff

Airfare and Visa

• Airfare, visa and re-entry permits are the responsibility of the Intern (The school will provide the necessary documentation for a Non-Immigrant visa)
